In music this week, we practised rhythms on the xylophone and the drums with Mr Holley.




YEAR 1 T

In RE we have been learning about a Jewish festival. We made our own Sukkahs and decorated them with Jewish symbols.




YEAR 3

YEAR 4

We have been busy writing instructions for: How to make a Volcano! We were very industrious and showed a great deal of effort in mixing the ingredients to create a dramatic eruption. We then reviewed our instructions to determine how successful they had been.



YEAR 5

We have used drama in our writing lessons in order to connect with the characters we are exploring in our class book. The book is called, 'Crossing the Wire'. We thought about the emotions, experiences and actions to try and create empathy for the characters we were portraying whilst acting. We were really good at using our improvisational skills. We also demonstrated that we have a keen sense of drama in the way we use props.



YEAR 6

In Maths this week and last we have been learning Algebra. We started by learning about input and output rules before finally reaching a stage where we were able to work out the unknown value. We used the virtual manipulative app to help us see how to work the value of x .
