## COVID Update

In the event that your child has COVID symptoms or has been told to isolate for other reasons it is crucial that you follow these guidelines immediately and you do not return your child to school until they have either tested negative or have completed their period of isolation. If you are awaiting COVID test results you must not come to school under any circumstances. A reminder that in the event that we need to close a year group or send children home due to a positive COVID test, learning can continue through the use of Google Classroom. This will be available for all school age children in Reception, Years 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6. Letters were sent out in October that contained the information you need to log into your Childs Google Classroom account and their username and password for IXL - if you need that information again please let us know as soon as possible.

## Want more practise for Maths, spelling, grammar and punctuation?

The school has bought into 2 packages that you can use at home with your child.

The first is IXL which can be accessed though either an app or the website. Children in Year 6 should be spending 90 minutes a week using IXL to consolidate learning in school, Year 5 - 80 minutes, Year 4 - 70 minutes, Year 3 - 60 minutes, Year 2 - 50 minutes and Year 1 - 40 minutes. If you need a reminder of your childs password please note that a letter was sent out in October containing all the information you need.

The second is also an app called Manipulatives or can be accessed through the brainingcamp website. The app is used in school during lessons to help children understand and consolidate new concepts taught. Access to this at home means that they can use the same tools to complete tasks at home with you.
