Science **Religious Education**

Forces and Magnets:

- Compare how things move on different surfaces
- Notice that some forces need contact between two objects, but magnetic forces can act at a distance
- Predict and observe how magnets attract or repel some materials but not others
- Compare and group a variety of objects on the basis of whether they are attracted by a magnet, identify magnetic materials
- Describe magnets as having to poles

History

Benin Kinadom:

- BCE stands for 'before common era' (before the year 0 and CE for 'common era' after the year 0
- A primary source is a work that gives original information. It is something that comes from a time being studied or from a person who was involved in the events being studied.
- The Ancient Kingdom of Benin is located in modern day Nigeria in West Africa. It was given its name by Portuguese invaders
- The 'Golden Era' of Benin stretched from 1400 - 1600 CE; this is similar to the Tudor period in Britain
- Benin had rulers called Obas and was famous for its sophisticated artwork e.g. the Benin **Bronzes**
- The British Empire invaded and colonised the Benin Klngdom in 1897
