Strategic Priorities

- 1. Implement the Primary Advantage Teaching, Learning and Assessment Policy so that it consistently informs teaching practice and impacts on pupil progress
- 2. Embed oracy so that pupils have secure understanding of key vocabulary and concepts and listen to the speaker carefully / add to a conversation meaningfully
- 3. Secure the graduated response so that the needs of pupils with SEND are rapidly identified and effective support and funding lead to accelerated progress
- 4. Embed phonics provision so that teaching is precise and well-paced and pupils make accelerated progress
- 5. Develop effective practice in the EYFS so that pupils make rapid progress from starting points

Issues to be addressed through continuous school improvement mechanisms

- 1. Further embed and develop a mastery approach in maths across all phases so that all children make good or better progress
- 2. Develop and embed the behaviour policy so that there is consistent understanding of aims and application of strategies by all stakeholders
- 3. Improve attendance and reduce persistent absence and poor punctuality
- 4. Strengthen relationships with parents through effective communication, provision of parent / learning support events and community social events
